# The Preamble of the Articles of Incorporation of the Society of Colonial Wars

"WHEREAS, It is desirable that there should be adequate celebrations commemorative of the events of Colonial History which took place within the period beginning with the settlement of Jamestown, Va., May 13, 1607, and preceding the battle of Lexington, April 19, 1775;

THEREFORE, The Society of Colonial Wars is instituted to perpetuate the memory of those events, and of the men who, in military, naval, and civil positions of high trust and responsibility, by their acts or counsel, assisted in the establishment, defense, and preservation of the American Colonies, and who were in truth founders of this Nation. To this end, it seeks to collect and preserve manuscripts, rolls, relics, and records; to hold suitable commemorations, and to erect memorials relating to the American Colonial period; to inspire in its members the fraternal and patriotic spirit of their forefathers, and to inspire in the community respect and reverence for those who public services made our freedom and unity possible."





## 2025 Distinguished Book Award Presentation and Luncheon, September 20th Omni Hotel, Richmond



The GSCW Awards Committee is honored to present the winner of the Distinguished Book Award to Virginia DeJohn Anderson, Ph.D. Her book, New England's Generation: The Great Migration and the Formation of Society and Culture in the Seventeenth Century, was published in 1991 by the Cambridge University Press and truly has stood the test of time with Dr. Anderson's innovative approach to understanding American Colonial history. Dr. Anderson looked at not individual immigrants to America but, instead researched the close to 700 family units of immigrants from towns across England to New England. She looked at their reasons for leaving England, their patterns of settlement in America, and their search for economic security. Her work shows the creation of the original New England foundational myth of the Great Migration forming the basis for the America we know today.



Virginia DeJohn Anderson, Professor Emerita of Early America at the University of Colorado Boulder, received her B.A. summa cum laude from the University of Connecticut and then, as a Marshall Scholar, earned an M.A. degree from the University of East Anglia in Norwich, England. She then received M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Harvard University. In addition to New England's Generation, she also is the author of *Creatures* of Empire: How Domestic Animals Transformed Early America (Oxford University Press, 2004) and *The Martyr and* the Traitor: Nathan Hale, Moses Dunbar, and the American Revolution (Oxford University Press, 2017). Her third book was named the

Journal of the American Revolution Book of the Year for 2017 and won the Connecticut Book Award for Nonfiction. She is beginning a new book that focuses on Daniel Gookin, a seventeenth-century Atlantic world traveler who lived in England, Ireland, Virginia, Maryland, and Massachusetts. The book will not only explore Gookin's experiences, but also those of the servants and slaves who worked for him. Professor Anderson has received fellowships from the American Council of Learned Societies and the National Endowment for the Humanities. She is also the co-author of a U.S. history textbook, **The American Journey: A History of the United States** (Pearson, multiple editions). She retired from active teaching in Spring 2021.
